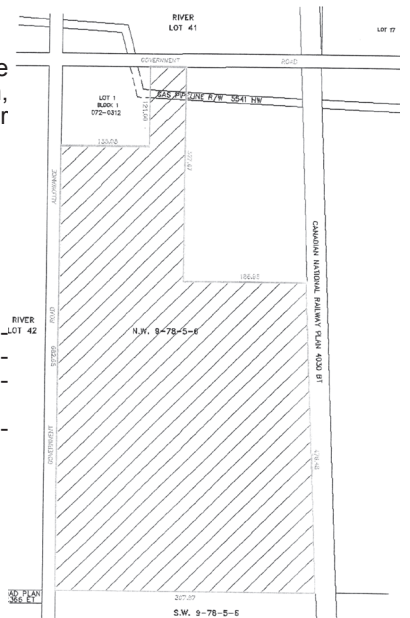

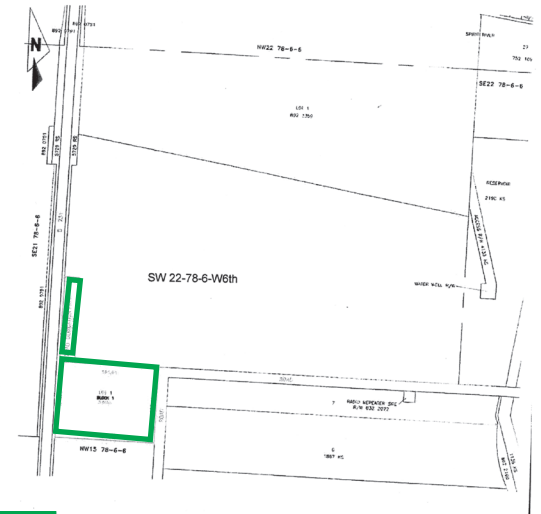

The purpose of an MDP is to provide a "big picture, forward looking" land use planning framework to guide long term development decisions. Public input is critical to the process as it ensures that future policies reflect the interests and needs of the community. You are invited to attend a Public Open House to view the M.D. of Spirit River draft MDP and to provide your feedback regarding how the MDP policies accommodate future growth and development in the region. Highlights from the MDP Residents Survey will also be presented at this session.
