School Support Notice Form Facts Sheet

- In a portion of the Municipal District of Spirit River, both a public and a Roman Catholic separate school district exist in the same area.
- When property is sold, the corporation, cooperative or cooperative association is required to file with the Municipal District of Spirit River this School Support Notice.
- A School Support Notice filed by a corporation, cooperative or cooperative association is effective in the taxation year following the year in which the School Support Notice is filed.
- A notice given by a corporation, cooperative, or cooperative association shall state that the information in the notice has been approved by a resolution of the shareholders, the members or the directors, as the case may be.
- When the corporation has shareholders, the notice shall designate to the separate school district the proportion of the property of the corporation in the district that is assessable for school purposes that the value of shares owned by shareholders who are separate school supporters bears to the total value of all shares of the corporation.
- The notice of a corporation or cooperative that does not have shareholders or of a cooperative association shall designate to the separate school district the proportion of the property of the corporation, cooperative or cooperative association in the district that is assessable for school purposes that the number of members who are separate school supporters bears to the total number of members.
- If this School Support Notice is not returned to the Municipality, the corporation's property would be assessable for public school purposes and the taxes on such property will be directed to the Alberta School Foundation Fund and redistributed on an equal amount per student to public and separate school board in Alberta.
- Because the Constitution establishes Alberta's public and separate school systems on the basis of religion (either Protestant or Roman Catholic) school board and tax collecting authorities are allowed and required to ask for the declaration contained in this form.
