ROAD CLOSURE

The MD of Spirit River No. 133 has received an application from Darcy White of Box 669, Spirit River, Alberta, T0H 3G0 to close the road allowance to the public all that portion of the statutory road allowance which forms the South boundary, of the South West Section Sixteen (16), Township Seventy-Nine (79), Range Five (5), West of the Sixth (6th) Meridian going East for approximately ¼ of a mile.

As Per Policy PWS.14, Leasing Road Allowances, the Landowner must advertise their intention to determine if there are any public objections and appeals. If there are appeals registered with the MD a public hearing will be held before deciding to proceed to First reading of a Bylaw. A complete copy of the policy can be obtained from the MD Website or office.
