

RURAL CRIME PREVENTION & COMMUNITY SAFETY TRAINING

Join the <u>Canadian Municipal Network on Crime Prevention</u> (CMNCP) and partners for a virtual training session on crime prevention and community safety planning in the rural context. This one-of-a-kind training is developed and led by CMNCP, the only organization in Canada focusing on rural crime prevention from a multi-sectoral perspective. To date, CMNCP has trained over 400 participants in 150 communities across Canada.



Duration

12-hour virtual training delivered over three 4-hour sessions



Certificate

All training participants will receive a certificate upon completion of the training
