Fire Advisory

Due to the heat wave expected for the next few days and the Fire Danger level moving from “High” to “Extreme”, within the boundaries of the MD No. 133 of Spirit River, along with neighboring jurisdictions in Northwestern Alberta, are now under a FIRE ADVISORY.

This level is meant to inform the public that the fire hazard rating has increased. Fire pits and controlled burns are still allowed, but that extra care is now required. Larger scale brush piles may still be allowed to burn, as long as the landowner has fire suppression measures in place and is providing ongoing supervision over their fire. A Fire Advisory also acts as fair warning that a more restrictive alert may be coming if the situation does not improve, or if we start to experience severe winds.
