CONTROLLED BURNS NOTIFICATIONS

Please notify us before you burn. Those who do not advise of controlled burns are subject to a \$500 fine. These rules apply year-round. When calling for a burn notification, please contact the MD Office at (780) 864-3500 Monday through Friday before 4:15pm.

REMINDER

Tax penalties of 2% were added on September 16, and an additional 2% will be added on the following dates: October 15, November 15 and December 15 for any amounts outstanding for this year and 10% will be added on January 1, which will also include any other amounts owing such as penalties on top of the outstanding 2022 taxes so PLEASE make your payment to avoid these penalties.

NO SPRAY AGREEMENT

This is a friendly reminder that the "No Spray Agreement" or "Spray Exemption" forms need to be filled out and submitted to the office prior to June 1st. The form has been updated and can be found on the MD website or picked up at the Municipal administration building.
